



## Chairman's Report

In year 2018-19, The Joyous Foundation Limited has been active in organizing activities to provide a healthy, happy and stimulating environment to children and youth in need by music education in Hong Kong.

The annual key fund-raising event, “眾樂樂 Jam Sound” Band Concert for Charity was successfully conducted on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2019 (Friday) at the Music Zone@KITEC, Hong Kong. This event was aimed at raising funds to continue supporting the <Music for All> Programme that sponsors children's musical training courses. With good support from committee members and members of the Joyous Foundation, donors and media, HK\$101,700 was successfully raised from that event and the committee members will continue to raise funding from other events in the coming year. The Programme continues to support three schools, the Yuen Yuen Institute No.3 Secondary School (YY3 School), the CUHK FAA Thomas Cheung Secondary School and the Po Leung Kuk Wong Sing Shu Primary School starting from Sep 2019 to provide music training courses as an extra-curricular activity in these secondary schools with a view to developing students' interest in music, building their self-confidence and improving their self-esteem. And this year, the Programme will expand to support the Po Leung Kuk Wong Wing Shu Primary School for new music classes.

More meaningful events were participated by the committee members, members of the Joyous Foundation and the participating students in this year. More variety of experience including live performances at indoor and outdoor music shows with professional musicians were arranged with support from more supporting organizations. A summary of events, selected photos and media exposure are shown in Appendix A.

Finally, I wish to acknowledge the devotion, effort and significant contribution by our Executive Committee and all the support of members of the Organization. I take this opportunity to thank all who have supported us; and look forward to enjoying their continuing support in future.
